Eureka Moments

Ever had an experience where everything came together and you felt you were doing what you were born to do? That's an inner witness that you are in your area of call. Jot down these experiences and what you think they tell you about your calling. (Look back at your responses in *Destiny Events* (12.1) if you completed that exercise.)

Direct Revelation

What has God directly spoken to you about your call, through His inner voice, words, dreams, or visions? What do you have an inner witness to pertaining to your call? Be bold about what you think you've heard. Even if you aren't certain, write it down here as something to look at.

Affirmation/Confirmation

What has God spoken to you through the people around you? If you've received strong affirmation in a gift or skill, someone you respect has named who you are, or you've received an important word or Scripture from someone, put it down here.

Key Scriptures

What key verses has God given you concerning your destiny? Is there a passage you are repeatedly drawn to because it expresses the essence of who you are and what's in your heart? Record those verses and the purpose insights that go with them here. Check your margin notes in your Bible or old journals if you need ideas.





Childhood Dreams

Sometimes God speaks clearly to children about their future, even when they don't know it is Him. What did you want to be as a kid? What did you want to do when you grew up? Who did you want to be like? Jot those items below, and if you can, identify what attracted you to that role. Don't get hung up on the outward role or the image ("I want to be a fireman"). Instead, look for what in that role that attracted you.

Design, Passion and Preparation

Take some time to go back and review the exercises you've done in the areas of Design, Passion and Preparation. Are there things you wrote down that are more than personal insights—that you sense are direction from God? Jot them down here.





Inheritance/Community

Think about your family, community and other groups you strongly identify with. What part of your call has been passed down to you (i.e. a family business, farm or lineage in a certain profession)? What strong values and traditions from your community or family influence your sense of call? How does your heritage make you part of a larger calling? (Exercise 13.3 can help you flesh this out.)

Revelation Summary

Once you've finished each category, step back and look it over. What are the common themes? What jumps out at you? Summarize what revelation tells you about your destiny.
